- Any test data (local benchmarks, NWEA, state tests) is organized to display students in different proficiency levels
- Once the test is administered and scanned back, the data is immediately available for analysis
- Teachers view an online report and then export the data to Excel
- In Excel, they create action and resource plans

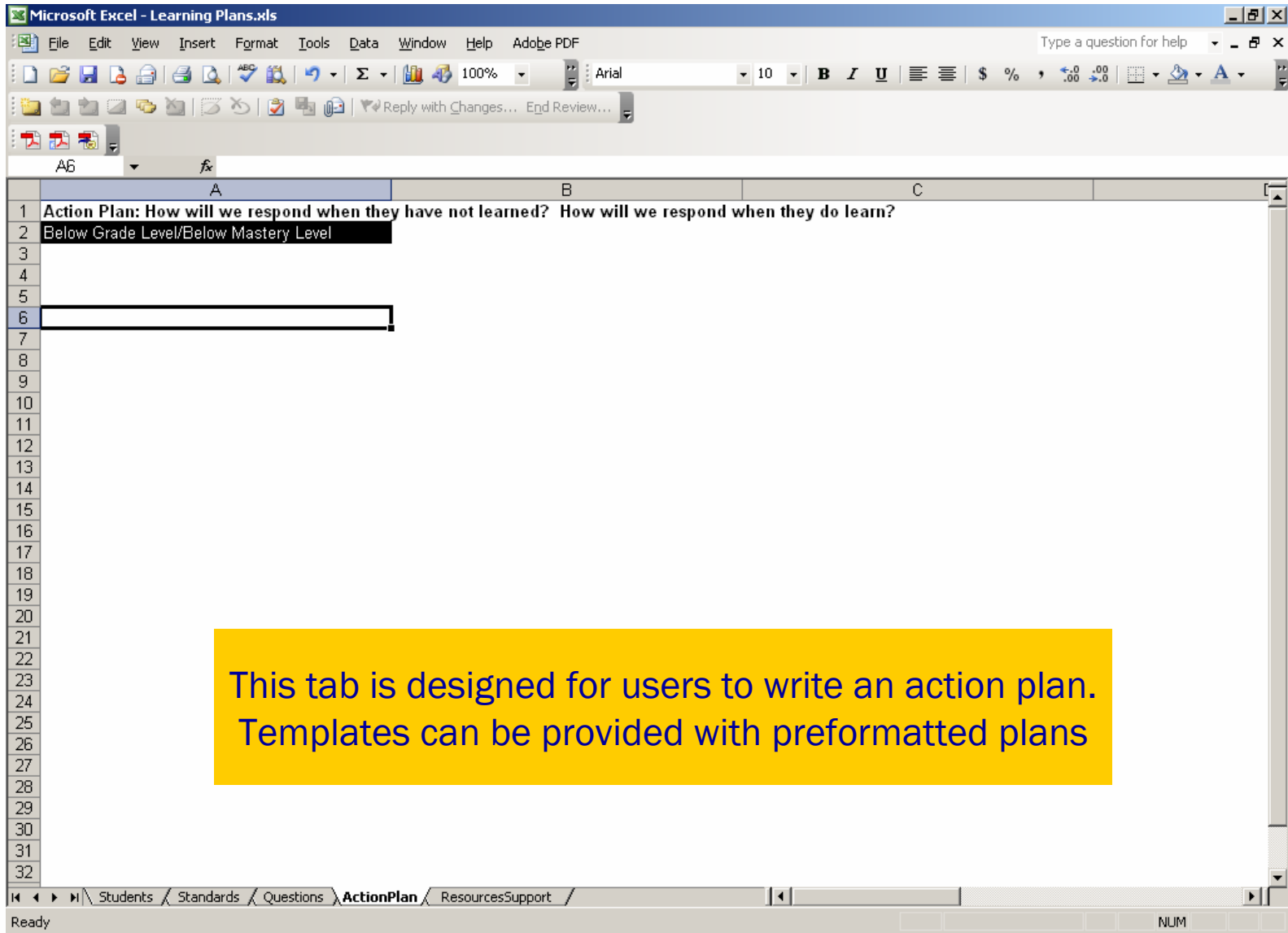
